- Trusted partner that can do close to inherently governmental work (OFPP Policy Letter 11-01)
- Serves as a pivot point connecting ideas and solutions across HHS, the private sector, and all of government
- Safe zone where government and private sector share data and proprietary information confidently and securely
- Independent perspective to bridge the gap between government and private sector with only the public interest in mind
- Long-term insights to guide and accelerate work
- Built to mobilize quickly to tackle urgent challenges

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The Health FFRDC:

- Provides a unique vehicle to explore options and refine requirements before initiating government action or conducting a commercial acquisition
- Solves complex problems that benefit from interdisciplinary or deep studies and analysis
- Develops innovative solutions and leverages expertise across MITRE, government, academia, and private industry
- Creates new technologies, prototypes, and reports
- Pioneers tools that enable the visualization of data, policy changes, and the future of healthcare

The Health FFRDC is operated on behalf of the government by MITRE.
